

# MEDICAL COMMANDER

## Check List

- Identify and mobilize medical team members. Ask if any Auxiliary has medic, EMT, paramedic, nurse, or doctor experience via Street Captains. If so, have them report to you at the Lodge.
- Dispatch team members as necessary to assist injured residents as reported by Street Captains or search and rescue personnel.
- Set up central TRIAGE area at Lodge, or other usable site, with signs designating areas for care:
  - "I" Immediate
  - "D" Delayed
  - "M" Minor
- Assist Street Captains via radio in triage during door-knock and interventional passes. Ask they attach triage tape: Immediate, Delayed, Minor, or DEAD to injured.
- Assign a scribe to record treatments using CERT Form #5, provide copies to IC/OC and external Radio Commander (for relay to City/County EMS)
- Obtain from Logistics Commander (LC) and set up necessary treatment supplies and equipment in central triage area.
- Assign the Medical Evacuation (Medi-Vac) location and communicate this to IC, LC, and ECOM.
- Coordinate with LC to organize conveyances to move injured between field, designated treatment areas, and Medi-Vac. Attach medical form from top of refrigerator to victim if available.

- MORGUE: Set up secured perimeter area downwind and downhill of treatment area with body bags (and IDENTIFICATION tags).
- Keep IC/OC informed of status and any issues.
